

# SkateQuest Winter Break Fun Camp

## Parent Information and Required Forms

**Check-In:** Drop off is between 8:45-9:00am in the Main Lobby. Campers must be signed in each morning. Also, please discuss any afternoon transportation changes with a camp counselor in the morning.

**Creating a Safe Environment:** We are committed to maintaining a safe and healthy environment for customers and staff.

We are requiring masks for children ages 4-11. The SkateQuest staff will continue to wear masks. Children are able to remove masks for outdoor activities. We clean and sanitize all common-use surfaces frequently. We will also ask children to wash their hands before eating.

**Check-Out:** It is extremely important that every child is signed out in the afternoon. Check-out is at 2pm. A counselor will be located by Locker Rooms #5 and #6. Please do not leave with your child until he/she is signed out with the counselor at the check-out table. All children still at camp after 2:15pm will be automatically enrolled in After Care. Photo ID matching name on the pick-up authorization form is required!

**After Care:** Pre-registration is required to attend this program. Aftercare is provided from 2:15pm-4:30pm with camp staff. There is a flat fee of \$30/child/week. There will be a \$1 per minute charge after 4:30pm.

We find that most children are hungry by 3pm, SkateQuest does NOT provide snacks during aftercare, please be sure to provide additional snacks or money for the Café.

Payment for aftercare is due before the first day of camp

**\*\*\*\*No After Care Thursday\*\*\*\***

Come Enjoy the Ice Show at 12:00am. Pick-up begins immediately following the show/free skate- No Supervision is Provided after 12:30pm.

**Late Arrivals/Early Pick-up:** Please stop by the front desk so that a counselor can be notified.

**Participation:** We do our best to provide activities suitable for all ages and ability levels. However, we do have the occasional child who is reluctant to participate in activities that may include ice skating. In these cases, we will NOT force the child. Alternative activities will be provided.

**The Beginner Skater:** If your child has never skated, skated very little, or is apprehensive about the idea of ice skating please let me know upon arrival, so that an off-ice safety talk may be conducted prior to taking the ice. This helps children get familiar with proper skating techniques.

**Safety is our top priority.** Helmets are **STRONGLY** recommended for all beginner skaters and are **REQUIRED** for participation in Ice Art, Broomball, and Hockey Lessons. SkateQuest **DOES NOT** rent or provide helmets. Please check your camper's bag before the morning drop-off to be sure you have the required equipment. **Campers will not be allowed to participate in Ice Art, Broomball, or Hockey without a helmet.**

**Please do not send your child to camp with a cell phone or tablet. They have been broken, stolen, or lost in previous years and are a distraction during camp activities. Should there be any emergency, we will call you and inform you. Your child's safety is our first priority.**

**During lunch, campers watch a movie.** Many of the movies we own have a G rating, however, some are PG (such as Shrek or Moana). If you have an objection to PG ratings, please inform the counselors at check-in upon arrival Monday morning.

**Please label all children's belongings brought to camp.** Also, do not allow children to bring anything of value to camp as things might get lost or damaged (e.g., video games, cell phones, tablets).

**There are a few items each child will need in order to make the week flow smoothly:**

1. **Helmets** are STRONGLY recommended for all beginner skaters and are REQUIRED for participation in Ice Art, Broomball, and Hockey Lessons. SkateQuest DOES NOT rent or provide helmets.
2. **A water bottle.** It's hot outside and we're going to be working hard inside!
3. **Sneakers or other closed-toe shoes.** Besides running around during various camp activities, keep in mind, people walk around with blades on their feet throughout the facility and accidents do happen. Therefore, socks and sneakers are strongly encouraged.
4. Please have your camper wear or pack a pair of **tall socks** (above the ankle bone) for skating as it will reduce the chance of rubbing/blisters from the skates.
5. **Warm clothing** (sweatshirt, sweat pants, and gloves) for the rink are mandatory.
6. An **extra change of clothing**/sweater/jacket is important in case clothing gets wet.
7. Bag **lunch** (SkateQuest will provide one morning snack). Our café also offers a menu for campers Monday through Thursday for \$7/day.

Enclosed is the emergency medical release form and permission slip. If they have not yet been completed and returned, please have these forms with you on the first day of camp. **EXPECT A DELAY IF THEY HAVE NOT BEEN COMPLETED AHEAD OF TIME.**
